Dissenting opinions The Chairmen of Parliament considers as "Inadequate". The question referred as well to procedural issues, namely, in our opinion, before elaborating constitutional changes should be held plebiscite and/or referendum about essential changes in constitution, forasmuch we consider that such issues should be decided by people in democratic countries. The mentioned issue irritated the Chairmen and we think that in the created situation it would be more appropriate to send him our opinions in written form, at the same time we consider to send them to the Venice Commission.
